## One Jersey Cash 5 Ticket Wins \$72,697 Jackpot in Gloucester County

**TRENTON (March 25, 2019)** – One lucky ticket matched all five numbers drawn winning the \$72,697 Jersey Cash 5 jackpot from the **Friday, March 22**<sup>nd</sup> drawing. The **winning numbers** were: **07, 27, 29, 38 and 39** and the **XTRA number** was: **05**. The lucky retailer that sold the winning ticket is **Glassboro Deli and Produce, 350 N. Delsea Dr., Glassboro in Gloucester County**.

Acting Executive Director James Carey said, "We are thrilled that the winning jackpot ticket was sold at Glassboro Deli and Produce. The retailer will receive a bonus check for \$2,000 for selling the winning ticket. Overnight, they have become one more 'lucky location' for the very fortunate lottery winner."

Carey announced that there were 249,178 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four of the five numbers drawn, 47 ticketholders won \$482 each and 4 others won \$2,410 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three of the five numbers drawn, 1,324 ticketholders won \$17 each and 268 others won \$85 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly 3,570 ticketholders each won \$2 for correctly matching two of the five numbers drawn with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
