Pick-6 Rolls to \$7.7 Million for Sept. 9 Drawing

TRENTON (Sept. 6, 2019) – The Pick-6 drawing on September 5 produced **ten** winners of **\$2,863** all of whom matched five out of six white balls drawn. One of those tickets was purchased with XTRA, multiplying the prize to **\$5,726**. The \$7.7 million drawing will be held Monday, September 9, 2019.

The **winning numbers** for the **Thursday, September 5** drawing were: **08, 09, 10, 27, 31 and 47**. The XTRA **Multiplier** was: **02**. By adding XTRA for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn.

Acting Executive Director James Carey announced that there were 572,638 tickets purchased for the drawing and of those sold, thousands were prizewinners! For correctly matching four numbers, 549 ticketholders won \$49 each and 84 others won \$98 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three numbers 9,776 ticketholders won \$3.00 each and 1,576 others won \$6 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly 10,934 ticketholders each won \$2.00 for correctly matching two numbers with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
